Approval of Minutes: The minutes from the September meeting were approved, via email, last year.

Financial report: Amy reported that she spent approximately \$125.00 on the items for the Adult Foster Care Homes for Christmas gifts. A check was received from the Red Flannel Days Committee, but it was not for the amount of \$750.00, which was the amount we were told we would receive for providing workers for the parade line up. We are waiting for an answer from Faith as to why we didn't get the full amount.

Old Business:

- A. Millage: Amy reported that Ron did return the unspent portion of the money the Auxiliary gave the millage committee for expenses. The amount returned was \$244.54.
- B. Coats were donated to the AFC residents. There were enough that every resident received a coat and there were a few left over that could be used for fire victims.
- C. Halloween – turn out was low for 2016. This, we believe, was because it was advertised too late.

New Business:

- A. Fundraisers –Molly has made arrangements to have the flower basket sale again for Mother's Day. The cost has gone up slightly, but we will keep the retail price to remain at \$15.00 per basket. Last year's plants were beautiful and very hearty. Profits will go towards AFC Christmas gifts again. We will also hold a Fall Mum sale in September. Cost per plant is \$3.75, with retail set at \$6.00. Profits from this sale have not yet been designated.
- B. Open seat – Amy's one year on the Auxiliary is up. She will talk to Linda VanHouten to see what needs to be done.
