Minutes of meeting held April 20, 2017

Unfinished Business:

Tri-River "Spring Into the Past" open house is May 6 and 7 from 11 am to 5 pm. Theme is "Fashions through the Ages". Besides our clothing exhibits, we could also feature hair care fashion items like our electric curling machine and the various hair items in the display case; and also feature "care of fashions" items in our laundry exhibit upstairs.

Discussed mounting the original AOOG emblem to hang in the inside, as well as a moveable screen to conceal the furnace when it isn't in use. Clair said he had something he thought would work.

Museum advertising will again be placed in area campgrounds, including some of the Tri-River booklets and a map to show location of our museum.

New Business:

Hosting sign-up sheet for "Spring Into the Past" weekend and rest of year was circulated.

Judy suggested we purchase some dress forms/mannequins for better display as needed. She was allowed up to \$200 to seek and purchase.
