The Oakfield Township Historical Commission meeting was called to order at 10:00am by President, Clair Bouck. Since there were no corrections or additions, the report was approved and placed on file. A brief financial report was given.

In unfinished business, J.Gager reported on the May Second Grade tours. In the Tri-River report, she encouraged members to attend the July 19 Tri-River luncheon at Belrockton. The cost is \$10 which includes a speaker on quilting. Tri-River will also sponsor a bus trip in October to the Sanford/Midland area. Cost is \$10 which includes lunch. S.Bouck reported on the Gleaner's visit April 23 in which they worked on an inventory of our museum holdings. She also reported on the supervisor's input regarding museum signs on M57 and the mystery of locating an early 1900s Girl Scout camp across from Ziegenfuss Lake.
