In new business : Bill Landstra presented the museum with many item from his personal collection. He also gave permission to sell or trade any which were not usable to us, Dec 21 was set for the Christmas get to gather at Winter Inn, S.Bouck gave some ideas on possible rotating displays for smaller items, she also encouraged members to invite one person to become a member to our group by next Spring. J.Gager questioned who was responsible for placing flags on Veteran's graves as there is a fairly recent one at Oakfield Cemetery. The local VFW and Legion posts will be contacted. She also suggested we research those in our township who served in WWI and put together some type of display.

E.Jackson motioned to adjourn, seconded by R.Salyer, motion passed.
